Faculty Recruitment for Iwate University (Assistant Professor, Female only)

1. Position and Number of Positions: 1 (one) assistant professor (female) (tenure-track)

2. Affiliation:

Faculty of Agriculture, Department of Food Production and Environmental Management, Food Systems and Management Course

3. Field of specialization: Agricultural Environmental Engineering and Agricultural Information Engineering-related

4. Subjects to teach

Food Systems and Management Course conducts education and research on the advancement and the informatization of the technology related to agricultural-food production.

We are looking for a candidate who can be in charge of Exercises in Information Processing (shared), Food Industry Systems Laboratory I, II (shared), etc. as well as supervision of graduation research.

5. Qualifications

- (1) A female.
- (2) PhD degree holder.
- (3) Person who has enthusiasm for education and research in Food Systems and Management Course.
- (4) Person who is willing to participate in the management of Iwate University.
- (5) Person with enough language skills (Japanese and English) to perform the above duties.
- 6. Starting date: As soon as possible after April 1, 2024

7. Term of employment: 5 (five) years

A tenure review will be conducted by seven months prior to the expiration of the 5 year tenure-track term. Tenure (assistant professor, permanent) will be granted if the applicant is deemed to achieve the target values required for granting tenure.

An interim evaluation will be conducted by three years from the start of employment. In case that particularly outstanding achievement is observed in the interim evaluation, the eligibility for granting tenure may be discussed at that time.

9. Research support

Applicants who pass the document screening will be invited for an interview. In this interview, applicants will be asked to introduce your research in English. The interview will be conducted in person, while the travel expenses for the interview are the responsibility of the applicant. An online interview may be permitted under certain circumstances.

The following documents must be submitted at the application.

- (1) A full curriculum vitae (with photograph, any format)
- (2) A list of research and teaching achievements.

 Publications must be labeled as refereed or non-refereed (see attached)
- (3) Three reprints (or copies) of major publications
- (4) Past achievements in education and research, and ambitions for future education and research (about 2 sheets of A4 paper)
- (5) Names and contact information (affiliation, address, telephone, and e-mail) of two references
